PURPOSE/SUMMARY:

The FHWA has, as a result of Executive Order FL-12-01, dated June 25, 2012, for Emergency Event Tropical Storm Debby, authorized funding to be provided to the Department for relief from the damage inflicted by said event. This agreement provides for reimbursement to the City of Jacksonville for certain costs and expenses incurred as a direct result of Tropical Storm Debby. FHWA requires a Resolution providing authorization to enter into the agreement and to receive the Tropical Storm Debby funds at 80% of the total cost for the Nocatee Parkway Erosion Repair Project. Execution of this resolution, will then initiate FHWA's action to create the Agreement between FHWA and COJ, which will then be forwarded to COJ for execution. The City has already awarded and funded a contract for the Nocatee Parkway Erosion Repair from Stormwater Enterprise Funds. Reimbursement from FHWA will replace those funds.
