ORDINANCE 2015-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 (EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (H) TO SECTION 20.110 (MAYORAL TRANSITION) TO PROVIDE FOR TRAINING TO STAFF DESIGNATED FOR MANAGEMENT, COORDINATION AND/OR OVERSIGHT OF CERTAIN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS FOLLOWING A MAYORAL TRANSITION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2013, the Task Force on Consolidated Government was created by then-Council President Bill Gulliford with a charge to undertake an in-depth review of the history, formation, and operation of the consolidated government of Jacksonville, including a full examination of all departments, divisions, boards, commissions, and independent authorities; and

WHEREAS on October 14, 2014, the Task Force on Consolidated Government issued its final report, "Blueprint for Improvement II" with recommendations for action to improve the government and enhance operations, structure and efficiencies; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force on Consolidated Government recommended certain changes to the *Ordinance Code*, including training of City staff and employees who manage, coordinate and have oversight of responsibilities falling under certain interlocal agreements with Baldwin, Neptune Beach, Atlantic Beach and Jacksonville Beach following a mayoral transition; and

WHEREAS, amendment to Chapter 20, Ordinance Code, is required

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Chapter 20 (Executive Office of the Mayor), Ordinance Code, to add a new subsection (h) to Section 20.110 (Mayoral Transition), Chapter 20 (Executive Office of the Mayor), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 20. EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR

PART 1. GENERAL

* * *

Sec. 20.110 Mayoral Transition.

* * *

(h) It shall be the duty of an outgoing Mayor to transmit to the Mayor-elect during the transition process a written document outlining the City's current responsibilities and obligations for provision of services under the terms of the various interlocal agreements between the City and Urban Service Districts 2, 3, 4 and 5. The Mayor-elect shall ensure that each department, division, or office within the City government that manages, oversees or has direct or indirect responsibilities regarding the coordination, management, oversight of, or provision of services pursuant to those interlocal agreements provides appropriate training to the staff designated for management, coordination and/or oversight of such functions to ensure their understanding of the components of each of the particular interlocal agreements and the City's responsibilities for continuity of service provision under those interlocal agreements.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
