5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 (EXECUTIVE
6 OFFICE OF THE MAYOR), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ADD A
7 NEW SUBSECTION (H) TO SECTION 20.110 (MAYORAL
8 TRANSITION) TO PROVIDE FOR TRAINING TO STAFF
9 DESIGNATED FOR MANAGEMENT, COORDINATION AND/OR
10 OVERSIGHT OF CERTAIN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS
11 FOLLOWING A MAYORAL TRANSITION; PROVIDING AN
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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14 **WHEREAS**, on August 27, 2013, the Task Force on Consolidated
15 Government was created by then-Council President Bill Gulliford
16 with a charge to undertake an in-depth review of the history,
17 formation, and operation of the consolidated government of
18 Jacksonville, including a full examination of all departments,
19 divisions, boards, commissions, and independent authorities; and

20 **WHEREAS** on October 14, 2014, the Task Force on Consolidated
21 Government issued its final report, "Blueprint for Improvement II"
22 with recommendations for action to improve the government and
23 enhance operations, structure and efficiencies; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the Task Force on Consolidated Government recommended
25 certain changes to the *Ordinance Code*, including training of City
26 staff and employees who manage, coordinate and have oversight of
27 responsibilities falling under certain interlocal agreements with
28 Baldwin, Neptune Beach, Atlantic Beach and Jacksonville Beach
29 following a mayoral transition; and

30 **WHEREAS**, amendment to Chapter 20, *Ordinance Code*, is required
31 to implement such changes; now therefore

1 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

2 **Section 1. Amending Chapter 20 (Executive Office of the**
3 **Mayor), Ordinance Code, to add a new subsection (h) to Section**
4 **20.110 (Mayoral Transition).** Section 20.110 (Mayoral Transition),
5 Chapter 20 (Executive Office of the Mayor), *Ordinance Code*, is
6 hereby amended to read as follows:

7 **CHAPTER 20. EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR**

8 **PART 1. GENERAL**

10 **Sec. 20.110 Mayoral Transition.**

12 (h) It shall be the duty of an outgoing Mayor to transmit to
13 the Mayor-elect during the transition process a written
14 document outlining the City's current responsibilities and
15 obligations for provision of services under the terms of the
16 various interlocal agreements between the City and Urban
17 Service Districts 2, 3, 4 and 5. The Mayor-elect shall ensure
18 that each department, division, or office within the City
19 government that manages, oversees or has direct or indirect
20 responsibilities regarding the coordination, management,
21 oversight of, or provision of services pursuant to those
22 interlocal agreements provides appropriate training to the
23 staff designated for management, coordination and/or oversight
24 of such functions to ensure their understanding of the
25 components of each of the particular interlocal agreements and
26 the City's responsibilities for continuity of service
27 provision under those interlocal agreements.

28 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
29 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
30 without the Mayor's signature.
