Appropriate funds to implement the following: (a) acquire one repeatedly flooded and damaged property at 4604 Fremont Street through the Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL); (b)enter into agreement with Joseph and Kory Murphy, owners, for the expenses to acquire the property, demolish structures and slabs, and remove debris associated with the project; and, (b) file a perpetual Open/ Space Conservation easement as required by FEMA. FEMA will pay 100% of the costs of the project as the Federal Share. The property owner will not have a Local Share of project expenses. The City has no funds invested in this project.
