## PURPOSE/SUMMARY:

- Please provide the Real Estate Division with authority to request the legislation necessary for the City Council to approve the conveyance of one (1) fee parcel and two (2) Perpetual Easements for drainage in accordance with Section 122.421 (b),
- and authorize the Mayor and Corporation Secretary to execute all the necessary documentation to convey said fee parcel and the Perpetual Easements to the Florida Department of Transportation.
- These parcels are needed by FDOT for the widening of this portion of I-295 from the Dames Point Bridge to north of Pulaski Road to eight (8) lanes from four (4) lanes, and additional drainage infrastructure to I-295.
- Parcel 106 contains 19,537 square feet within the right-of-way of Pleasant Oaks Road and is for the purpose of providing maintenance access, and the construction of, a storm water management pond.
- Parcel 803 contains 5,379 square feet and is within a City owned drainage ditch. Parcel 804 contains 12,900 square feet and is within the right-of-way of Houle Road. These perpetual easements are for the construction and maintenance of storm water outfall systems. Maps are enclosed for your reference.
