IMPACT - FINANCIAL/OTHER: The noise training and certification occurs every three years. Rutgers University will conduct the training on-site in EQD's office which reduces the cost substantially. Training will be for ten individuals and is anticipated to cover eight EQD employees and two Jacksonville Sheriff's Office employees.

- **WAIVER** A waiver of Ordinance Code 360.602 is also authorized to allow monies in the fund to be used for training. At the Environmental Protection Board public hearing held on February 9, 2015, and the Board meeting held on March 13, 2015, Board members discussed the necessity of a waiver of ordinance code provisions, and determined that the use of the funds for training purposes was a worthwhile and beneficial use of the Board's trust fund monies. The proposal was approved with a unanimous decision of the Board.
