#### PURPOSE/SUMMARY:

This will authorize the Mayor to execute Local Agency Program (LAP) Agreements with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) supporting the replacements of Coastline Drive and Liberty Street Bridges. These LAP agreements are necessary for the City to receive Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funding through the FDOT in FY2021. These two bridges are currently part of the Five Year Work Program and can receive up to \$3.75 Million each in FHWA funding towards their replacement costs. The City's CIP authorized the full value of the project over FY16 and FY17 at \$17 Million and \$20 Million respectively. This LAP Agreement will spell out the terms for the City to receive \$7.5 Million in reimbursement in FY2021. Once the reimbursement is received, the funds shall be used to pay down the debt incurred by the COJ to replace these bridges.
