IMPACT - FINANCIAL / OTHER:

The Company is seeking public investment through the State of Florida Qualified Targeted Industry (QTI) Tax Refund program and Florida Flex Training (FFT) grant program. Total public investment proposed is up to \$3,285,000. The QTI award is \$2,250,000, \$5,000 per job. The City portion of the QTI is 20 percent of the basic award, \$1,000 per new job, not to exceed \$450,000. The State portion is 80% of the award, \$4,000 per job not to exceed \$1,800,000. The FFT grant totaling \$1,035,000, \$2,300 per job is 100% funded by the State of Florida. The total amount of City incentives would be up to \$450,000. The total State incentives would be up to \$2,835,000.
