The Solid Waste Division respectfully requests legislation necessary to waive Ordinance 260 Part 2 sections 260.201(a) License, 260.206(1)(2) Temporary Storage of Waste Tires and 260.208 Hours of Operation in support of the Third Annual Waste Tire and Snipe Sign buyback event.
