PURPOSE/SUMMARY:

Please provide the Real Estate Division with authorization to request legislation for City Council approval to close, abandon and/or disclaim a portion of a sixty (60) feet wide unopened and unimproved right-of-way established in River Oaks, Plat Book 15, Page 35, dated September 25, 1935, as shown in the attachments.

The right-of-way is unopened and unimproved and contains no infrastructure. There are no objections to this request from the State, Municipal and Utility Agencies which may have interests in this right-of-way. The City of Jacksonville has no need, present or future, for the right-of-way.

The application is made by John A. Rush III and Pamela J. Rush for the purpose of expanding their residential property. The portion to be closed is twenty (20) feet wide and approximately one hundred forty three (143) feet long. It is adjacent to the boundary of the applicant's property. The applicant has paid the \$1,688.00 application fee.
