IMPACT - FINANICIAL / OTHER: The first mortgage loan of \$4,386,030 expires on June 15, 2016. Due to ever changing market conditions since 2009 the project value is not sufficient at this time to completely refinance both the first and second mortgage loans into one loan. As a result the Developer is requesting their first mortgage lender renew their loan for an additional five years. Additionally, the Developer is requesting the City extend the NWEDF loan for a term of 11 years, through May 1, 2026 and interest only payments for an additional 24 months. These loan extensions will allow additional time for the real estate market to recover value sufficient for the developer to refinance the loan on or before May 1, 2026. The developer, Third and Main, LLC is current on all loan principal and interest payments to the Bank and the City, property taxes and assessments are paid in full, and there are no liens on any of the condo parcels comprising the project site. The developer will remain responsible for all principal and interest payments on the loans and cover any and all operating deficits. The loan will be personally guaranteed by the the principals of Third and Main, LLC, William R. Cesery and Barbara Cesery.
