PURPOSE/SUMMARY:

To appropriate funds (\$111,967) from FEMA through the Florida Division of Emergency Management for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP). This grant provides the City with Federal funding for a Wind Retrofit Project at nine City of Jacksonville fire stations for the expenses of permitting, labor and materials to install protective missile-impact resistant coverings. The impacted fire stations are 19, 35, 37, 43, 49, 50, 52, 57, and 58. This requires matching funds to be provided by the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department. The original funds were appropriated through ORD 2014-0466 (annual City budget ordinance).

This grant provides funding to reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of wind damage to city-owned infrastructure at nine fire stations. It further reduces claims under the City's insurance program and improves Jacksonville's rating through the Duval County Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) for floodplain and mitigation management.
