Project Grace is evaluating an expansion within the JIA CRA area versus moving it engineering services team to Atlanta. Grace is proposing to retain 30 existing and adding 54 engineering jobs, over two years; at an average wage of \$66,098. The engineering jobs support a high-impact global manufacturing company. Grace has indicated the combination of State of Florida and City of Jacksonville incentives is a material factor in its decision to expand its operation in Jacksonville, Florida. The private capital investment to support the proposed new jobs totals \$2.1 million. Building renovations, additional IT infrastructure and testing equipment comprises the private capital investment. Grace proposes to retain 30 existing jobs and create 54 no later than December 31, 2018 at an average wage of \$66,098 plus benefits.

IMPACT - FINANICIAL / OTHER:

Grace is seeking public investment through the State of Florida Economic Development Programs. The total amount of public investment proposed is \$448,200. The proposed QTI Tax Refund Program incentive is \$6,000 per job totaling up to \$324,000 and a Florida Flex Training grant of \$2,300 per job up to \$124,200. The QTI award at 150% Florida Average Wage is \$4,000 per job. The High-Impact Industry Bonus is \$2,000 per job. The City portion of the QTI award is 20% up to \$64,800 (\$1,200 per job). The State of Florida portion of the QTI award is 80% up to \$259,200 (\$4,800 per job). The private capital investment to support the creation of the new jobs is \$2.1 million. The county portion of ad valorem taxes generated from the new private capital investment is greater than the cost of the City's QTI payment obligation. The project generates a positive ROI for the City of Jacksonville.
