Please accept this letter as stating the City of Jacksonville's position regarding the designation of specific features of Hemming Park as locally designated landmarks.

As stated in my letter dated July 12, 2016, the City has no objection to the Confederate Monument being designated individually as a local landmark. Additionally, the City has no objection to the individual local designation of the large coquina rock on the northeast corner of the Park now bearing a bronze informational plaque added by the Daughters of the American Revolution in 1928. The rock was the original road marker for the intersection of the historic Alligator Road and Old Kings Road.
