Pursuant to the provisions of Section 30.204 and Section 656.129, *Ordinance Code*, the Planning Commission ("PC") respectfully offers this report for consideration by the Land Use and Zoning Committee ("LUZ").

● Recommendation by JPDD: Approve Approve with Conditions Deny

● Recommendation by PC to LUZ: Approve Approve with Conditions Deny

● Recommended Planning Commission Conditions* to the Ordinance:

1. Prior to requesting a final building inspection or occupying the facility in any manner, the lead horizontal and lead vertical design professionals shall submit to the Planning Department separate certification letters confirming that all horizontal and vertical components of the development have been substantially completed, and all conditions to the development order have been satisfied. This condition shall apply to both phased and non-phased developments.
2. Outside sales and service shall be limited to the front of the establishment. Any outdoor customer area at the rear of the building shall be approved through the Zoning Exception process

● Recommended PC Conditions that can be incorporated into the Written Description: None

● PC Vote: 7-0

● PC Commentary: There were several people in support of the application. Most notably, representatives from the Springfield Improvement Association and SPAR spoke in favor of bringing new small businesses in the area. The biggest impediment to development is vacant buildings. There was one speaker in opposition who felt churches deserved to be protected from the proximity from alcohol serving establishments. Tyler Loenhardt, Duval County School District representative indicated the school district has no opposition due to the fact the schools are not in direct view of the subject parcel.
