SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION REVIEW OF 2017-0009

Losco Road, from Old St. Augustine Road to Hood Road South, is the directly accessed functionally classified roadway. Losco Road is a 2-lane divided collector in this vicinity and is currently operating at an unacceptable LOS F. Losco Road segments have a maximum daily service volume of 14,742 vpd and a 2016 daily traffic volume of 25,634. This road segment currently <u>does not have sufficient capacity</u> to accommodate the traffic generated by this development.

This proposal is for 40 dwelling units of ITE 210 Single Family Homes, which would generate a total of 381 vpd, which exceeds the amount of available capacity for this property.

* <u>This development is subject to Mobility and must be submitted to the Concurrency and</u> <u>Mobility Management System Office for review. Due to this development exceeding the amount</u> <u>of available capacity for this property, a traffic analysis study measuring the impact of the</u> <u>development on the directly accessed functionally classified roadway must be submitted prior to</u> <u>the submission of the final 10-set plan.</u>
