Based on maintenance recommendations by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has requested approval to expend the remaining current balance in the State of Flc Internal Improvement Trust Fund, which receives annual contributions from Duval and Nassau Counties for emergen shoreline stabilization repairs along Sawpit Island. Recent high tides and storms have eroded areas along the shorel Portions of the roadway connecting Sawpit Creek Bridge and George Crady Bridge are in Genger of collapse. Resolt 2000-121 authorized the Mayor to enter into an agreement with FDOT, the Florida Department of Environmental Prot (FDEP) and Nassau County for the operation and maintenance of the Old Nassau Sound Bridge, known as the Georg Crady Bridge Fishing Pier State Park, but failed to identify authority to approve maintenance expenditure requests for FDEP. A Resolution is needed to authorize the Mayor or his designee to approve the expenditure from the trust fund account by FDEP and for future requests as needed by FDEP for maintenance repairs.  FDOT constructed a new bridge over the Nassau River, which is the boundary line between Nassau County and the to Jacksonville. The City, the FDEP and Nassau County requested that FDOT leave the old bridge and its approaches allow the old bridge to be used as a public recreation facility and is now known as the George Crady Bridge Fishing Pier State Park. In anticipation of FDOT's transfer of ownership to the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trus Fund of the State of Florida (Trustees) for the use and benefit of the Division of Recreation and Parks, FDOT, who at own expense maintained the bridge, including structura
