Funding will come from the Northwest TID (SF 183) of the Combined Northbank CRA. The project will rebate 62.5% of the City County portion of the Ad Valorem taxes generated by the project (the City/County portion only). Amounts will be budgeted out of the Northwest TID (SF 183) annually. As the project only rebates a portion of the taxes generated the overall net effect of the project enhances the financial projections for the Northbank Combined TIF in the years to come. The project is estimated to generate \$14.55 million over a twenty year period, while the maximum cumulative payments for the project are \$9.00 million. Payments are estimated to begin in FY 2019 or later depending on the completion date of the project.
