PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Council Research will complete this form for Council introduced legislation and the Administration is responsible for all other legislation. (Minimum of 350 words - Maximum of 1 page.)

A Study has been completed that investigated solutions to drainage and flooding problems in the Newtown neighborhood. Anticipated improvements would include improved storm drain systems, curbs and gutters and storm water detention/treatment ponds. Study estimates a total cost of approximately \$40 million to complete this project. Current funding available for a first phase is \$4.37M. The first phase proposed for the project would include acquisition of the pond site properties, design of the proposed improvements and construction of a stormwater treatment facility south of Beaver Street. Improvements would include portions of Morgan Street, Logan Street and Union Street. Community meetings have been held to inform stakeholders of the project needs and problems faced in acquiring large enough pond sites and/or increasing the capacity of the storm outfall system. An improved drainage collection system along with curb and gutter will provide an economic benefit to this neighborhood. Deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interest of the community because such deferral will result in the further delay of addressing drainage issues in the Newtown Area.
