PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Counce Introduced lealslation and the Administration is responsible for all other leaislation. (Minimum of 350 words - Maximum of 1 page.) Three bathrooms at each one of the three CTC buildings along with the fronting sidewalks, stairs and ramps are to be reconstructed to comply with current ADA requirements. These deficiencies were listed in the Department of Justice (Di 2013 survey and are part of the DOJ settlement agreement with the City. The design of the CTC Accessibility Improvements project started in 2014 as requested by Public Buildings. The projec went to bid on 04/02/15 and the low bid was \$489,000 (10.5% higher than the estimated cost). Public Buildings provided the additional funding and the project was awarded. The project set idle for more than a year and the awarded contract requested a 25% escalation without any substantiating justification. Therefore, the Sheriff's office requested the City to terminate the Contract and re-bid the project. Additional construction phases, penalties, security and stricter timeframes were requested by the Sheriff's office since the project is inside a jail. A revised estimated cost was provided to Public Buildings for \$795,000 considering the bid proposals for the other bidders on the first bid, the price increases since the design and the tighter construction requirements. Public Buildings requested to re-bid the project with additional funding from the ADA Compliance budget. The re-bids were opened on November 9, 2016 and the project with additional funding from the ADA Compliance budget. The community Transition Center has excessive slope in ramps and sidewalks, including the main entrance to the build the sally port and other entrances. Also, the 3 existing bathrooms in each building are not ADA compliant. The ADA work includes the removal, relocation and/or construction of: plumbing fixtures, piping insulation, drinking fountains, wall ti
