PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) This legislation is seeking authorization to execute and administer a 20-year franchise agreement to authorize Buckeye Terminals, LLC to locate a 1.6-mile liquid energy ethanol and other petroleum transmission pipeline and associated equipment in the City's right-of-way between 1509 Eastport Road and Buckeye's Jacksonville Terminal. The purpose of the pipeline is to allow Buckeye to pipe its liquid gas product between two of its separate receiving and processing facilities as part of its industrial production operations.				
The proposed pipeline would not function as a distribution system to service individual customers, but would be limited to transmission of the product for processing and storage. Ultimately, the blended product will be transported via tanker truck to wholesale distributors and retailers.				
In exchange for the use of 1.6 miles of the City's right-of-way, Buckeye is proposing payment of a franchise fee based on a price-per-linear-foot basis. The initial 2017 fee calculation would be \$4.37 per linear foot (\$35,832) with a 3% annual increase over the 20-year life of the agreement (final payment in 2037 of \$64,716). This fee amount determination is consistent with the typical franchise fee payments that Buckeye has negotiated with numerous other jurisdictions around the country. The price-per-linear-foot amount is equal to the highest fee that Buckeye is currently paying (New York).				
The franchise agreement and adoption legislation would need to waive the provisions of Chapter 711, Jacksonville Ordinance Code as it pertains to right-of-way franchise agreements and the calculation of the franchise fee. Buckeye has demonstrated a public need for use of the City's right-of-way by documenting its efforts to secure private property ownership or easements for locating the pipeline; however such efforts were demonstrated to be either prohibitively expensive or completely unavailable due to refusal to negotiate with the company.
