The Public Buildings Division was informed by JSO that the 26 year old Generator which backs up the electric service at the Montgomery Correctional Facility had failed inspection and was no longer serviceable. The generator services the water plant, two sewer pumps in the lift station, all lights/electrical and the air handler in the C - Wing. Without the generator, if power failure was experienced there would be no water or wastewater at the facility and JSO would have to relocate all inmates. Public Buildings contracted with a vendor to provide a standby generator, for which we are charged a monthly fee, until the generator is permanently replaced. Deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interest of the community because such deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of completing the needed replacement and could potentially cause a costly and logistically challenging inmate relocation in the event of a loss of power for an extended period of time.






