USA Quartz is a manufacturer of quartz slabs, used for counter tops. They don't currently have any operations in Jacksonville. USA Quartz is proposing to create up to 70 new jobs, at an average wage of \$49,920, no later than December 31, 2020. The project would include the company purchasing an old GE manufacturing building, which has sat idle for a number of years, for \$2 million. The company will also invest \$5.6 million in renovations and manufacturing equipment, at the site. The company will utilize Jaxport for importing and exporting activities, which may also help create additional offsite jobs. USA Quartz has stated that the City of Jacksonville incentive is a material factor in its decision to locate its new manufacturing operation in Jacksonville, Fla., as opposed to another port city, located in the southeastern U.S.

The 70 new jobs to be created will be for various positions, including IT and Finance. The new jobs will generate an additional \$3.49 million annually in new payroll (excluding benefits). Renovation of the existing industrial building will add to the commercial tax base. The company is seeking public investment through the Qualified Targeted Industry (QTI) Tax Refund program. The QTI incentive proposed is \$3,000 per job (up to \$210,000). The City portion of the QTI program is 20 percent of the award, or \$600 per job up to \$42,000, in total. The QTI award will be payable after the average wage and jobs created are verified by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity over the proposed four year payout, beginning in 2019.

The project has a positive ROI for the City of Jacksonville.

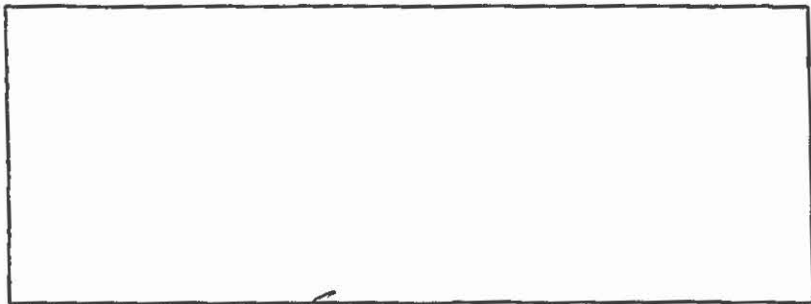




