The proposed legislation is a recommendation of the Industrial Development Revenue Bond (IRB) Review Committee, that the Mayor submit legislation to approve, for purposes of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code, the issuance by the Capital Trust Agency of its Revenue Bonds in one or more installments or series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$9,500,000. The bond issuance will be for the purpose of providing funds to be loaned by the Issuer to Seaside School Consortium, Inc., d/b/a Seaside Community Charter School, a Florida nonprofit corporation, and/or one or more related and/or affiliated entities for the purpose of 1) financing or refinancing, including through reimbursement, the acquisition, construction, improvement, installation and equipping of an approximately 36,000 square foot charter school facility and the acquisition and improvement of approximately 7.84 acres of vacant real property, upon which the charter school facility will be located, to accommodate approximately 600 students, to be known as Seaside Community Charter School and located North of Pioneer Drive bordered to the East by Sherry Drive and to the West by State Road 101, also known as Mayport Road, in Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida 32233; 2) funding of any necessary capitalized interest; and 3) payment of certain costs of issuing the Bonds.

There is no fiscal impact or obligation to the City of Jacksonville as a result of the issuance of these bonds.
