Please provide the Real Estate Division with authority to request the legislation necessary for City Council to approve the conveyance of a parcel by quit claim deed to FDOT, to approve the subordination of the City's interest in utility easements to FDOT, to approve the subordination of the City's interest in right-of-ways to FDOT, to approve the issuance of perpetual easements to FDOT within the City's right-of-ways, and to approve the issuance of temporary construction easements to FDOT in accordance with Section 122.421(b), City Ordinance Code, and authorize the Mayor and Corporation Secretary to execute all the necessary documentation to convey the aforesaid documents.

These parcels are needed for the FDOT University Boulevard Intersections Improvement Project. Parcels 104, 704A & B, and 105 are needed for the addition of a left turn lane from WB Atlantic to SB University. Parcels 100A, B, & C, 101, and 107A are needed for the addition of a right turn lane from NB University to EB Atlantic Blvd. Parcels 107 and 108 are needed to extend the existing right turn lane from SB University to WB Atlantic. Parcels 108, 708A, and 110 are needed to relocate Lawrence Place (City Street) further north, away from University/Atlantic intersection providing a safer connection to University Blvd. Parcels 800A-L are needed for the construction and maintenance of signalization features within the rights-of-way of the connection City streets. Parcel 806 is needed for Signalization/Lighting/ADA improvements.
