Jannet Walker Ford is a member of the Executive Team for Cubic Transportation Systems, a leading global integrator of payment and information technology and services to create intelligent travel solutions for transportation authorities and operators, headquartered in San Diego, California. She is vice president and general manager, Eastern Region, Americas, and has responsibility for overall operations and performance of Cubic programs in the region.

Her region includes Georgia where Cubic delivered Atlanta's Breeze smart card-based regional fare collection system and continues to provide maintenance services, as well as Miami where the EASY Card system is a major Cubic project that is expanding under a contract to add major upgrades for cloud-based services that will support mobile and open payment technologies. Other customers include the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority, the Maryland Transit Administration, and Autoridad de Transporte Integrado and the Metropolitan Bus Authority, the primary rail and bus public transport operators in Puerto Rico.

Walker Ford's extensive background in the public and private sectors has focused on information technology and transportation industries, specifically aviation, rail, and transit systems with more than 20 years of experience. Prior to joining Cubic, she was vice president and North America director of strategic programs and policy for Parsons Corporation and, previously, was the vice president and deputy program director for the Philadelphia International Airport's multimillion-dollar, multi-year Capacity Enhancement Program – which at the time was the largest such program in the United States. She also previously served as a Principal for Booz Allen Hamilton and both the deputy CEO and the Chief Information Officer for the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA).

Walker Ford serves on the Board of Directors for the American Public Transportation Association (APTA), American Public Transportation Foundation (APTF) and Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville as well as the Executive Board of the Women's Transportation Seminar (WTS). She also serves as Chair of COMTO's Women Who Move the Nation Awards.

In 2012, Walker Ford was presented the Professional Achievement Technology Award for Industry from the Women of Color's Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) Conference and has been named Woman of the Year Award from the Technology Association of Georgia's Women in Technology and Outstanding MBA of the Year by the NBMBA.

Walker Ford received her Bachelor's degree in Management Information Systems from the University of Memphis and a Master of Science degree in Business Administration from Central Michigan University, and has completed significant coursework toward her doctorate in Information Systems at Nova Southeastern University. She is also an alumna of Leadership APTA and the ENO Center for the Transit Leadership Executive Development Program.
