There were two speakers in opposition. Their concerns were development is outpacing road and school capacity and Gillespie Road is in poor condition. There were no signs posted and they are asking for a 2 cycle deferral until they can meet with the neighborhood.

The agent indicated that the staff report does contain a photo of a sign and when he was advised there were no signs a new sign was posted on August 23.

The Commissioners thought there are additional public hearings to defer the item if needed. The Commissioners agreed that school overcrowding is an issue, but that is not the responsibility of the developer, but the City and DCSB.
