PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) During heavy rains, the intersection of Ocean Street (SR 5) and Bay Street, has been prone to flooding, which has impacted local businesses. To alleviate this problem, the proposed improvements are to repair, replace and/or expand on the existing FDOT drainage system on Ocean Street from Forsyth Street to Bay Street. The purpose of this legislation is to appropriate grant revenue, which will cover the funding shortfall between the available funds and engineer's estimate for the construction of the project. Additionally, this legislation will move previously appropriated funds from Bay Street Improvements-DIA to Ocean & Bay St Drainage Improvements. Deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interest of the community because such deferral will result in the loss of grant revenue funds.
