The RI concluded that chemicals of concern included 1,1-dichloroethane, 1,1-dichloroethene (DCE), benzene, bromodichloromethane, chloroform, cis-1,2-DCE, ethylbenzene, m+p-xylenes, o-xylene, PCE, trans-1,2-DCE, trichloroethene, and vinyl chloride, all of which were found to be present above applicable criteria in soil and groundwater at the site.
