

**RESUME****Thomas G. Burnakis, Pharm.D.**

Dr. Burnakis received his Bachelors in Pharmacy from Temple University in Philadelphia, PA in 1978 and his Doctorate in Clinical Pharmacy from The University of Utah in 1982.

After thirteen years in Michigan hospitals and Universities he moved to Florida to take on the opportunity to develop a Clinical Pharmacy program at Baptist Medical Center in Jacksonville, FL. This grew during his 20 years tenure to a 15 person program of clinicians providing extensive dosing and consultative services to the medical and nursing staff at BMC Downtown.

Dr. Burnakis has held leadership roles outside of the hospital as well, serving on various committees for the local Health-System Pharmacy organization and culminating with being elected President of the society in 1997. From there he turned his attention to the state society, serving on committees and the Board, eventually being elected President of the State society in 2007.

In the community he has participated in various "brown bag" events where patients bring in their medicines and receive counseling on compliance and disease management. In addition he, along with Senior Activist Mary Terbrueggen, spearheaded a "Health Fair" program for Jacksonville Senior citizens held at the Mary L. Singleton Senior Center. He is also very involved in his church where he is a lay reader and long-time member of the Men's Breakfast Crew.
