## Robert P. Birtalan - Professional Bio -

Robert Paul Birtalan was born in Salem Ohio in 1951 where he lived until 1982. Robert graduated from Salem Senior High School in 1969 and in addition to his diploma he also earned a certificate for the successful completion of a 2-year vocational drafting program attended during his junior and senior years of high school.
