RE: Episcopal School Knight Campus PUD

Introduction

Episcopal School Knight Campus PUD is a proposed rezoning on 39.28 acres to Planned Unit Development (PUD). The property is located on the north side of SR-10 (Atlantic Boulevard), just east of Almeria Avenue. The rezoning is being sought to allow for enhanced Knight campus signage with matching architectural directional and traffic control signage and landscaped areas. Any future development would be allowed by PUD modification.

Accessibility

Access to the site will be provided via the existing access point on SR-10.

Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities

There is a sidewalk along SR-10 fronting the property. FDOT Bicycle and Pedestrian Gap Study, dated March 2018, indicates the section of SR-10 has a bicycle and a pedestrian LOS of D.

Programmed Improvements

There are no programmed capacity improvements in the vicinity of the project site.

Trip Generation

Trip generation was not completed as the use is existing. If any future development occurs, a trip generation analysis should be conducted.

Roadway Capacity

Table 2 shows the peak hour and maximum level of service volumes for SR-10 according to FDOT's 2016 Florida State Highway System Level of Service Report, dated July 2017.

The segment mentioned in Table 2 has sufficient capacity and FDOT does not identify any potential adverse impacts on SR-10 as a result of the rezoning.
