- Recommended Planning Commission Conditions* to the Ordinance:
 - 1. Provide a left turn lane meeting FDOT standards on Panther Creek Parkway at the proposed road. Ensure there is adequate visibility around the curve in the vicinity of Royal Dornoch Drive for vehicles turning left.
 - 2. Sidewalks shall meet the requirements given in the Land Development Procedures Manual.
 - 2.3. The posted speed limit on street shall not exceed 25 Miles Per Hour (MPH) subject to the review and approval of the City's Traffic Engineer.
 - 3.4. Prior to the first final inspection within any phase of development, the owner or their agent shall submit to the Planning and Development Department for its review and approval either (a) an affidavit documenting that all conditions to the development order have been satisfied, or (b) a detailed agreement for the completion of all conditions to the development order.

*Additions made by PC to the proposed Jacksonville Planning and Development Department ("JPDD") conditions are <u>underlined</u> and deletions are indicated with a strikethrough.

- Recommended PC Conditions that can be incorporated into the Written Description: None
- PC Vote: 6-0
- PC Commentary: There were two speakers in opposition. Their concerns were additional traffic with the additional lots, drainage issues and reducing the posted speed limit on the streets. The Commissioners indicated a study is required for improvements to the entrance and there will be a second entrance on the south property line.
