Apostle Dr. Jeannette C. Holmes is an American Pentecostal/Holiness Minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. She is the Founder and Pastor of Hope Chapel Ministries, Inc. The year was 1973, a year in a decade characterized by the beginning of world-wide evangelism, the charismatic movement, soul-saving revivals, camp meetings, and a new breed of Holy Ghost filled, God fearing women and men preaching the anointed word of God.
