Sec. 108.411. - Temporary closure of public building; rental of alternative space.

All or a portion thereof of a public building may be closed in the event of a limited emergency pursuant to the provisions of <u>Section 122.107</u>. In the event this closure is ordered by the authorized official and adequate alternative work locations are not available within another public building, the official may request the Mayor to negotiate and enter into an emergency short-term lease agreement, under such terms and conditions as are determined by the Mayor, to lease alternate work space for such period of time as is necessary to correct the emergency condition existing, but in no event to exceed 90 days without prior Council approval. The chief administrative official of an independent agency may lease alternative work space as provided herein without the Mayor's assistance, if the respective governing board of the independent agency approves this procedure.
