PURPOSE: White Paper (Explain Why this legislation is necessary? Provide; Who, What, When, Where, How and the Impact.) Design and construction of a right turn lane at Scott Mill Road and Mandarin Road. Improvements will include a southbound right turn lane on Scott Mill Road, crosswalk, new sidewalk, utility relocation, and clearing and grubbing for intersection sight distance. The improvements will help address the queue during the morning and afternoon peak hours for southbound traffic on Scott Mill Road turning left onto Mandarin Road. Together, the operational improvements with the right turn lane, crosswalk, sidewalk, and the intersection sight distance improvement will help accommodate traffic at the intersection and in the area. These improvements will reduce congestion and allow for a more efficient, safe travel. Deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interest of the community because such deferral will result in the unnecessary delay of replacing critical transportation infrastructure.
