SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION REVIEW OF 2019-0159 COGGIN AVENUES

COLLISION CENTER PUD

Philips Highway (US 1), from SR 9A to Southside Boulevard, is the directly accessed functionally classified roadway. Philips Highway is a 4-lane divided arterial in this vicinity and is currently operating at 94% of capacity. This Philips Highway segment has a maximum daily capacity of 39,800 vpd and a 2017 daily traffic volume of 37,500 vpd.

- 1. This development is subject to mobility fee review.
- 2. Any traffic study, plans and any roadway modifications will be subject to the review and approval of the Florida Department of Transportation.
- 3. Access to the site via Philips Highway must be subject to FDOT access management guidelines.
