This project will install approximately 615 new countdown heads at 81 state intersections. The City will receive the countdown heads from the Florida Department of Transportation through the Federal Highway Administration. The Local Funding Initiative Request from the Florida Senate is to install approximately 1,924 new countdown heads at 292 intersections. Since the time of the request, FDOT has addressed many locations. The remaining 81 state intersections will be addressed with 615 new countdown heads.


