Please provide the Real Estate Division with the authority to request the legislation necessary for the City Council to adopt the attached Affordable Housing List. Pursuant to Ordinance 2018-871-E Section 122.423(b), surplus properties appropriate for affordable housing shall be placed on an affordable housing inventory list as required by Sections 166.0451 and 125.379, F.S., for adoption by the Council no later than July 1, 2019 and no less often than every third year thereafter. The properties have been circulated for need and no need to retain the properties were indicated.

Additionally, we are requesting an amendment to the new language approved in 2018-871-E in Chapter 111, Ordinance Code, to delete the account created in Section 111.920(b), Ordinance Code, as this account would be commingling federal and local funding sources in the same Subobject, and this is not permitted per federal regulations for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program. We also request an amendment to Chapter 111, Ordinance Code, to create a new and separate self-appropriating special revenue fund in Chapter 111, Ordinance Code, with the same requirements as Section 111.920(b), Ordinance Code. We also request to amend Chapter 122, Ordinance Code, to substitute previous account references to Section 111.920(b), Ordinance Code, to the newly created special revenue fund reference.
