Pursuant to the authorization by the governing body of the Jacksonville Housing Finance Authority (the "JHFA"), I conducted a public hearing on March 20, 2019 at 10:45 a.m. at 214 N. Hogan Street, 8th Floor, Room 825, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, with respect to the contemplated issuance by the JHFA of its Homeowner Mortgage Revenue Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 (the "Bonds").
